Welcome to Left Hand Running December 2025, our monthly newsletter. I hope you all are having a fine holiday season. We have a couple items of note;


- December 12th, 5-9pm, Elmhurst Public Library Polar Express set-up




Saturday, November 8th was our November club meeting. Members present ballasted our OO gauge T-Trak layout. Photos are below;
